Course description "German Language and Culture" Language levels: beginner, A1, A2, B1, B2, C1 (CEFR)

The syllabus offers a variety of conversation exercises and discussions, current listening and reading texts combined with modern task-based grammar training. Under the expert guidance of our qualified and experienced teachers, you can deepen and expand your oral and written German skills. Specific study techniques such as reading strategies and presentation skills will also be practised. The lessons follow the aims of communicative competence of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages in an entertaining and inspiring way and will assist your independent learning process. The language lessons take place in the morning.

Course with 72 teaching units à 45 minutes = 4 ECTS credits for regular attendance and proof of performance

Exercise courses and seminars in the afternoon

Depending on your language level, you can choose from exercise courses on phonetics, grammar, vocabulary and Everyday German practice, or seminars on different current issues in the areas of cultural and social sciences, e.g. history, literature, film, environment, European policy and interculturality. There is a total of 20 teaching units per one exercise course or seminar. You can attend a maximum of two afternoon sessions.

One exercise course or one seminar = 1 ECTS credit for regular attendance

Language laboratory

At our language laboratory (Sprachlabor), students can use self-study materials for individual practice of listening comprehension, grammar and pronunciation by choosing from a wide range of audio material and online exercises.

Language laboratory = 1 ECTS credit for at least 30 hours of study
