Course Descriptions

Brush up your German A1 – A2*

This course is ideal for beginners with little to no prior knowledge of German. This immersive learning experience will help you gain confidence in using essential, commonly used and everyday expressions. Basic grammatical structures will be covered as well, all under the guidance of our expert teachers who are all native speakers. This course could be the starting point of your learning journey or provide you the perfect opportunity to refresh your already existing language skills.

German Language Training B1*

This course will help you to strengthen and expand your written and oral German language skills, with a focus on intermediate-level grammatical and language structures. Listening, reading and conversational exercises will help you to enhance your active language production and enable you to understand the main points of texts and personal or professional conversations.

German Language Training B2 – C1*

If you already have upper-intermediate German language competences and aim at refining them, this is the right course for you. Throughout the course, you will have the chance to broaden your knowledge of upper-intermediate and advanced vocabulary, expressions and grammatical structures. This course is designed to enhance your German language proficiency, allowing you to discuss complex topics with confidence and to use German independently.

***The four core language skills (reading, writing, listening and speaking) will be practiced during the course. Each course will be tailored to the needs and requirements of the participants.**
