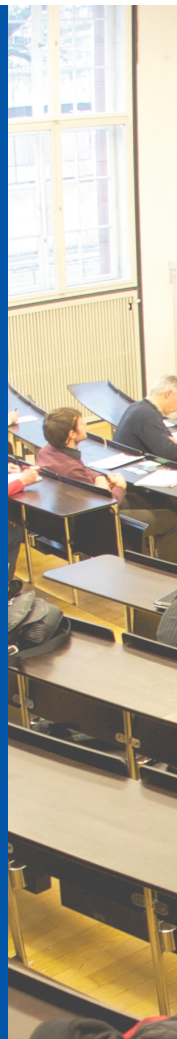

Quality Assurance in English-Taught Degree Programs

We offer a systematic certification procedure to evaluate the linguistic and communicative quality of teaching in English.

Assessment at a glance:

- English medium instruction-specific criteria
- Authentic classroom observation
- Triangulated feedback based on student evaluation, teacher self-assessment and detailed expert analysis



Degree programs can obtain a five-year quality seal if at least 80% of long-term teaching staff are certified.

Workshops

One day participant-centered workshops to foster didactic strategies and language use for different teaching contexts in English.

Semester Course

Weekly course covering didactic and linguistic aspects of teaching in English with a multilingual, multicultural student body. The course culminates with participant mock lessons and detailed feedback.

Tailored Training

Pursue more individualized learning goals via classroom observations and/or one-on-one training. Institute-/team-specific workshops are available upon request.

E-learning Resources

Self-paced, compact modules which allow teachers to gain insights into communicative teaching strategies and reflect on their use of language in the international classroom (see picture on the right).

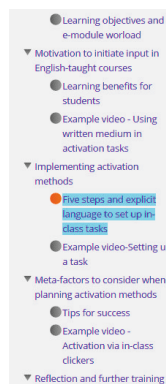
All training measures on offer are available to all levels of teaching staff (soon to be) tasked with communicating their expertise in English in the international classroom.

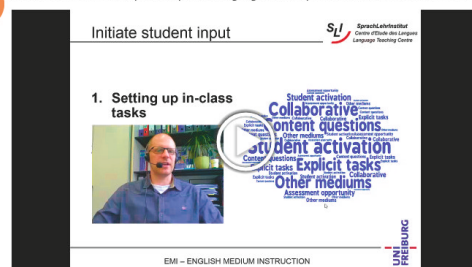
