The National Socialism **Documentation Centre is a** multimedia museum on the history of Freiburg in the 20th century. The National Socialist dictatorship from 1933 to 1945 is the main topic of the exhibition, which also sheds light on the events leading up to this dark period in history and on its consequences up to the present day. The historical exhibition is designed to be interactive: Four chronologically organised, individually designed "time rooms" invite visitors to engage intensively with the past. All text displays in the exhibition are written in German, English and French.

Guided Tour: Uniseum (EN)

The Uniseum is the university museum of the Albert-Ludwigs-Universität. On over 1,000 square metres, you can take a walk through six centuries of university and scientific history. Following the concept of 'Astonishment - Research -Educating', you can discover the university's research work and teaching from its beginnings in the 15th century to the present day. Staging and interactive stations allow you to immerse yourself in a small university world of experience.

This guided tour of the Vauban neighbourhood, which was built on the site of former French army barracks, gives you an insight into Freiburg's most important sustainability projects for renewable energies, energy-efficient construction and car-free living.

Excursion Black Forest

09.08.2025, all day (DE/EN)

This coach tour through the southern Black Forest will give you an insight into the cultural landscape, which has been inhabited and alive for many centuries. During the ride, we will pass lakes, valleys and plateaus. We will visit a baroque church and an impressive monastery museum in St. Märgen. Then we will stop by in Titisee, which is a very well-known small town in the Black Forest. Many tourists come here allyear-round to enjoy the lake and the beautiful scenery of the mountains. In Titisee, you will also find many restaurants and souvenir shops. You can walk along the lakeshore and enjoy the beautiful view of the Feldberg, the highest mountain in the Black Forest.

Trip to Titisee (DE/EN)

10.08.2025, 10:10

Experience the most beautiful aspects of the Black Forest on a trip to Lake Titisee, where you can take in the breathtaking scenery and unique atmosphere on a relaxing walk along the lake. Along the promenade path you will find various shops selling cuckoo clocks and many other Black Forest souvenirs.





A Walk to Schlossberg (DE/EN)

12.08.2025, 17:45

Discover one of the best photo opportunities in Freiburg on our walk to Kanonenplatz! From this picturesque vantage point, you have a breathtaking view over the entire city and the surrounding nature.

Freiburger Bächle Tour (EN)

16.08.2025, 09:50

They are Freiburg's most famous sight besides the Cathedral: the small canals called "Bächle". In fact, the Bächle run through the entire city, totaling over 15 kilometres, with a unique feat of medieval engineering. They also harbour many secrets waiting for you to reveal. First question: why are they even there? The answer will astound many... but there's more.



Our tour begins at the Schwabentor, where we will explain the origin of the Bächle, which even many Freiburg residents don't know. Where does the water come from and how does the complicated network function without any pumps? Via the entrance to the Bächlestollen on the Schlossberg, we will head to the Gerberau (Tanners' Alley) and Fischerau (Fishermen's Alley), where the industrial canals are connected to the Bächle streams. Here we will learn a lot about medieval craftsmanship, the guilds and life in the town. Then, at Münsterplatz we will see a few very old 'original' medieval Bächle. On the way towards the university, we will learn about the energy generation from the water power of the industrial canals, which is still used today.

Guided Tour: Europark-Stadium (EN)

16.08.2025, 10:00

The 'new' climate-neutral football stadium in the west of Freiburg was opened in 2021 and offers space for 34,700 spectators. It is home to the Bundesliga club SC Freiburg. On this guided tour, you will get an insight behind the scenes of the stadium and learn many exciting facts about Freiburg's 'football temple'.





17.08.2025, 10:00

Freiburg's 'Mundenhof' is an outdoor paradise: many native and some exotic animal species live here in large enclosures and on extensive meadows, and are zoologically presented. Join us for a walk in the green spaces and greet the animals!



Museum Sunday (DE/EN)

17.08.2025, 10:00

Are you a fan of art or architecture? Then you should definitely visit the Augustinermuseum. At the centre of its collection are the original stone figures and stained glass windows of Freiburg Cathedral as well as medieval wooden sculptures and panel paintings. There is also an exhibition by Hans Thoma, an important 19th century German artist known for his distinctive Black Forest landscapes and genre paintings.

Hiking Tour at Kaiserstuhl (DE/EN)

Kaiserstuhl is a small mountain range of volcanic origin only around 15 kilometres distant from Freiburg. Discover the unique natural and cultural landscape with its rare animal and plant species, fascinating geology and great wine-growing tradition. The hike through the vineyards is light and relaxing.

Excursion Heidelberg

23.08.2025, all day (DE/EN)

With its numerous cultural and historical sights, Heidelberg is one of the most visited cities in Germany. From the world-famous castle ruins, you have a marvelous view of the Old Bridge and the Neckar. Our professional tour guides will tell you lots of interesting facts about the history of the castle and of the Romantic city. You will also have the opportunity to explore the picturesque old town, which is home to Germany's oldest university, founded in 1386.

A Walk to Günterstal (DE/EN)

On the southern edge of Freiburg lies the village of Günterstal, which offers direct access to the Black Forest. On our walk we will visit the Waldhaus, where you get to learn about the forest ecosystem. We will take a moment to admire the beauty of the city's forest. Over 40% of Freiburg's urban area is covered with forest! We will then walk to St Lioba's Monastery, built in the style of a Tuscan villa at the beginning of the 20th century.
