Guided Tour: Freiburger Bächle (EN)

06.03.2025, 15:00

Discover Freiburg's unique feature: the small canals, known as "Bächle" in German, that run through the old town. These canals, with a total length of 15 km, are a testament to medieval engineering. They have witnessed Freiburg's historical development and hold many secrets. Ever wondered why they exist in the first place? The answer might surprise you... Find out more during this tour!



The tour begins at Schwabentor, where the origin of the Bächle will be revealed—the fact that even many Freiburg residents are unaware of. You'll learn where the water comes from and how the intricate network functions without any pumps. From the entrance to the Bächlestollen on Schlossberg, we proceed to the Tanner and Fishermen district, where the industrial canals were connected to the Bächle flow. Here, you'll delve into medieval craftsmanship, the guilds, and town life. Afterwards, you'll see some of the original sections of the Bächle. On the way to the university, you'll discover how water power from the canals has been harnessed for power generation, a practice which is still in use today.

Guided Tour: Green City Vauban (DE)



Museum Sunday (DE + EN)

Are you interested in art and do you enjoy looking at paintings? Then you should definitely visit the Augustinermuseum. Its collection is centered on the original stone figures and stained-glass windows from Freiburg Minster, as well as medieval wooden sculptures and panel paintings. There is also an exhibition of Hans Thoma, an important nineteenth-century German artist, known for his highly distinctive Black Forest landscapes and genre paintings.

Hike to Günterstal: Waldhaus and St. Lioba Monastery

23.03.2025, 13:00

On the southern edge of Freiburg lies the Günterstal district, which offers direct access to the Black Forest. During our hike, we will visit the Waldhaus - an educational center which has the aim of increasing people's knowledge of the eco-system of the forest. We will take a moment to peek at nature's beauty of the city forest (btw. 40% of Freiburg city area is covered with forest). We will then walk to St. Lioba Monastery built in the style of a Tuscan villa at the beginning of 20th century.




How well do you know Freiburg? (DE+EN)
