Course description	This course is aimed at participants who have no previous knowledge of German.
	This is a general practice-oriented language course in which the four skills of reading, listening, speaking and writing are practiced. The focus is on grammatical structures and vocabulary. Reading and listening comprehension is trained systematically in authentic contexts. The oral and written skills are acquired and expanded through a variety of communicative exercises. Vocabulary training promotes the development of active expression skills. Grammar training is integrated into the reading, listening, speaking and writing tasks. Participants are expected to complete additional vocabulary and grammar exercises independently, outside of the class. Targeted phonetics training supports the correct pronunciation from the start of the course.
Course objectives (CEFR)	The participants will be able to understand and use familiar, everyday expressions and quite simple phrases aimed at the satisfaction of concrete needs. introduce themselves and others, and ask other people questions about themselves - e.g. where they live, what kind of people they know and what kind of things they have - and give answers to questions of this kind. communicate in a simple way if the other person speaks slowly and clearly, and is willing to help.
