<b>Course description</b>	<p><b>This course is aimed at participants who have completed A1.1.</b></p> <p>This is a general practice-oriented language course in which the four skills of reading, listening, speaking and writing are practiced. The focus is on grammatical structures and vocabulary. Reading and listening comprehension is practiced systematically in authentic contexts. The oral and written skills are acquired and expanded through a variety of communicative exercises.</p>
<b>Course objectives (CEFR)</b>	<p>The participants will be able to</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>➤ understand and use familiar, everyday expressions and quite simple phrases aimed at the satisfaction of concrete needs.</li><li>➤ introduce yourself and others and ask other people questions about themselves - e.g. where they live, what kind of people they know and what kind of things they have - and give answers to this kind of questions.</li><li>➤ communicate in a simple way if the other person speaks slowly and clearly, and is willing to help.</li></ul>
