Course description	<p>This course is aimed at participants who have reached at least level A2 and who want to improve their pronunciation.</p> <p>In this course, the participants will learn the most important phonetic rules of standard German. These rules are then applied in listening and speaking exercises. With the help of supporting movements, pronunciation tricks, visual aids and playful learning sequences, participants can experience and try out German phonetics and overcome possible pronunciation difficulties.</p> <p>Free, phonetically correct dialogic and monologic speaking in the context of everyday communication forms the central aspect of this pronunciation training.</p> <p>In addition, participants receive individual support according to their needs.</p>
Course objectives	<p>The participants will be able to</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ know the phonetic rules of standard German,➤ recognize and differentiate between different sounds and intonation patterns,➤ improve their pronunciation in everyday routine situations.
