

► Will there be a placement test?

Yes, the placement test will take place on Monday, 20. April 2020 at 6 pm in HS 3219, KG III.



► What shall I do if I can't be present at the placement test?

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I have already taken a course at the SLI.

If you have already completed a course at the SLI, you must still take the placement test again.

I have no knowledge of German.

You do not have to take the placement test if you are a <u>total beginner</u>. Simply tick the relevant box on the registration form. We will send you details of your course by e-mail.

However, even if you have <u>very low-level</u> German language skills, you must still take the placement test.

► How can I find my class and my classroom?

Information about your classroom will be sent to you via e-mail <u>by 4 pm on Tuesday</u>, <u>21th April 2020</u> at the latest. (You will be informed about your course level after the first session.)

► How do I register for a course?

1) Online-Registration

- When you click, Anmeldung/registration you will get to the Reservix page, where you can register for your desired course.
- After registering you can print out a ticket with the course information.
 Please bring your ticket (either a printout or an electronic copy) to the placement test.

2) Registration at the Information Desk (Universitätsstraße 5, 79098 Freiburg)

Registering in person at the Information Desk (ground floor) / Office DaF (2ND floor) is only required in exceptional cases. However, if you have choose this option, payment is only possible with a card. Payment in cash or via instalments is not possible.

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Can I get ECTS-Credits?

Yes, you can get max. 8 ECTS-credits.

► How much do the courses cost?

Students from other higher education Institutions in Freiburg (e.g. Universität, PH, EFH, KFH, Musikhochschule) The Student's ID card number is required to register. If you don't have a Student's ID card number, please email us at daf@sli.uni-freiburg.de	160 €
Fee Reduction Students who receive financial aid from the MWK BaWü, DAAD or another non-profit institution can apply for a reduction. The applicant must then present the required certificates to the Info desk (ground floor) / Office DaF (2 nd floor).	120€

► When do I pay the course fee?

The course fee must be paid immediately after registering. You have the following payment options:

1) Transfer

The bank details and your order number ("Verwendungszweck") can be found on the registration confirmation.





<u>Important:</u> Please state the order number that is specified in the confirmation ("Verwendungszweck") of your transfer order so we can match your payment.

2) Cash/Card payment at the SLI (Universitätsstr. 5, 79098 Freiburg)

You can also pay the course fee after registering online at the Info Desk (ground floor) / Office DaF (2nd floor) by card (credit/EC card).

► Can I use my voucher for the language course at the SLI?

Yes. The vouchers can be used for our language courses.

Procedure:

- 1. Select course and register via the SLI website.
- 2. Pay for the course at SLI.
- 3. Complete at least 70% of the course. You will receive a confirmation of attendance at the end of the course.
- 4. Submit this confirmation of attendance at the end of the winter semester 19/20 to voucher@service.uni-freiburg.de.
- 5. Service Center Studium will refund the course fee (80€/160€).
